Bernie Powers Band Foundation Provides New Laptop Computer to SP Band Program

THANK YOU to all who have made contributions to the Bernie Powers Band Foundation (BPBF) over the years. Thanks to you, this year the Foundation is providing a new laptop computer plus blank CD/DVD stock and ink supplies for the duplicator. The previously donated duplicator is used to make CDs/DVDs for all students and recruitment DVDs for the fifth grade students. The laptop will run software for the duplicator, act as a traveling computer for presentations/clinics & provide a tool for SOSP summer tour drill writing. Since 2005, the BPBF has provided 7 clarinets, 1 flute and 3 trumpets. These instruments stay with the school they're placed in, and will provide years of music instruction for many different students. With 10 concert bands, 7 jazz ensembles, 2 jazz combos, Sound of Sun Prairie, and 2 Sound Project groups, Sun Prairie's district-wide band program touches the lives of nearly 600 students.
